DRUG SCREENING CONSENT WAIVER
(Age 18 Yrs. or older)

As a condition of joining and participating in the Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department's Deputy Explorer Program, I, _____ **(participant being 18 years old or older)**, hereby give, release, and discharge the County of Los Angeles, the Sheriff of the County of Los Angeles, and officers, agents, servants, employees or officials of Los Angeles County, or the Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department, my written permission to screen my urine for the presence of illegal and prescription drugs/narcotics. I understand that the presence of illegal drugs/narcotics is a disqualifying factor and that it may be used to prohibit my participation, or continued participation in the Deputy Explorer Program.

I understand that my refusal to comply with this prerequisite to join the Deputy Explorer Program and/or my refusal to comply with a directive to submit to a drug screening by the Explorer Program Coordinator, or his/her designee, will result in my disqualification to join or continue in the program.

I understand that a drug screening kit, provided by the Redwood Toxicology Laboratory Inc. will be used to determine the presence or absence of illegal substances in my body. I understand that should I decide to contest the results of the screening, that an additional test will be conducted, using a new screening kit. I understand that should the results of the second test match the findings of the first test, that the LASD will consider the results to be conclusive and positive.

I hereby represent that I have carefully read, understand and agree with the contents of this document and sign the same of my own free will, giving my consent to have my urine screened for the presence of illegal substances. I further understand the consequences of refusing to submit to drug screening for the Deputy Explorer Program.
